- Senior Citizens



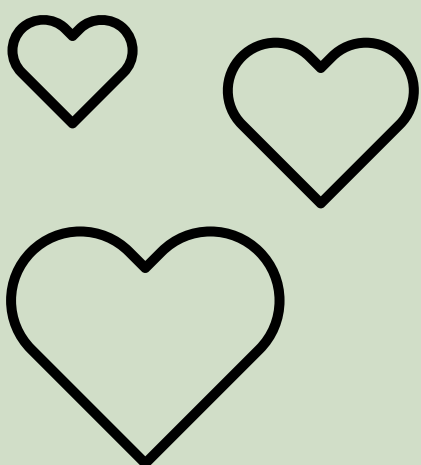
INDIVIDUALS WITHOUT A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

Despite these individuals paying taxes, this includes:

- Many Immigrants
- DREAMers
- Temporary US Residents

INDIVIDUALS WHO DON'T MAKE ENOUGH TO FILE TAXES*

- Less than \$12,000 per year for individuals
- Less than \$24,400 per year for married couples



INDIVIDUALS WITH MAJOR LIFE CHANGES IN 2020

- High-Income earners who lost their jobs due to COVID-19
- One individual in a couple that was divorced or estranged
- Parent/Guardian with a new baby**

*The IRS has introduced an online simple tax form to allow these individuals to receive a stimulus check. Unfortunately, many do not have access to the internet.

**The parent/guardian will not receive the \$500 check that individuals are getting per dependent for the new baby
