Jeanette is Associate Professor of Learning and Organizational Change at Northwestern University, with appointments in the School of Education and Social Policy, and (by courtesy) the Kellogg School of Management, the Department of Sociology, and the Institute for Policy Research.

At Northwestern, Jeannette also serves on the faculty advisory boards of the Innovations and New Ventures Research Office (INVO), the program in Science and Human Culture (SHC), and the Undergraduate Business Institutions Program (BIP).

Outside of Northwestern, Jeannette is a faculty member of National Arts Strategies, which provides executive education to cultural, arts, and social service organizations throughout the United States. She also serves on the editorial boards of *Sociological Theory*, *Journal of Technology Transfer*, and *Research in the Sociology of Organizations* and participates in panel and ad hoc review functions for the National Science Foundation.

Jeannette's published work appears in diverse journals such as *Management Science*, *Research Policy*, *Minerva*, *Sociological Theory*, *American Journal of Education*, and *Research in Organizational Behavior*. For over a decade, she has examined university-industry interactions, focusing on the translation of basic science into commercial application and the implications for careers, innovation, and public science.

Jeannette holds a Ph.D. from Stanford University and her research interests include innovation in science policy and practice; comparing public, private, and nonprofit forms of organizing; performance metrics, and institutional change.
